Promptly replace worn or broken parts.








#### To assemble Frame...



- 1a. Attach **Front Steel Fram**e into one side of one end panel.
- 1b. Secure using 2 x **Assembly Bolts**.



- 2
- 2a. Attach **Rear Steel Frame** into other side of end panel.
- 2b. Secure using 2 x **Assembly Bolts**.



- 3
- 3a. Repeat for remaining side panel.



- 4
- 4a. Flip **Change Centre** upside down as per image shown.
- 4b. Attach all four **Castors** by pushing onto the bottom of the end panels. Stand **Change Centre** upright.



- 5
- 5a. Lay **Change Pad** face down on a flat surface.
- 5b. Lay **Change Pad Assembly Arm** onto the **Change Pad**.



**NOTE: Ensure** the metal loops are facing up and that the horizontal bar sits between the pre-drilled holes on the Change Pad.




#### To assemble Frame continued...

- 6
- 6a. Attach one **Assembly Arm Fixing** over the horizontal bar of the **Change Pad Assembly Arm**.
- 6b. Secure with 2 x 10mm Screws.



- 7
- 7a. Repeat for other side



- 8
- 8a. Hook **Change Pad Assembly Arms** onto the back support tube of the **Change Pad Steel**Frame.
- 8b. **Ensure** the White screw plugs are facing downward on the opposite **Change Pad Steel Frame** support tube as per image shown.



- 9
- 9a. Insert one end of the **Change Pad Assembly** into the top holes of one end panel.



- 10
- 10a. Insert one **Assembly Bolt with Press Stud** into the front side hole and secure using the **Assembly Tool**.
- 10b. Insert one **Assembly Bolt** into the back side hole and secure using the **Assembly Tool**.
- 10c. Repeat for other side.



**NOTE:** This Assembly Bolt with Press Stud should align with the Change Pad webbing and press stud.



#### To assemble Frame continued...



11a. Connect press studs on **Change Pad** webbing with press studs on front **Assembly Bolts**.



#### To attach Bottom Shelf...



- 1a. Place **Bottom Shelf** in position as shown in image.
- 1b. Fold up sides and wrap end flaps around the vertical bars of the side panels.
- 1c. Secure using press studs as shown.



# To assemble Plastic Components...



1a. Place all **3 Storage Containers** side by side on the middle shelf rails.



- 2
- 2a. Place the **Left Front Tray** onto the front top support tube.
- 2b. Place the **Right Front Tray** onto the front top support tube, ensuring it clips into the left front tray.





# To assemble Plastic Components continued...



3a. Place bath tub into position as shown.

4a. Insert plug into bath drain hole.



# **Change Pad Operation...**

# To lower Change Pad...



1a. Disengage front change pad press studs.

2a. Lift **Change Pad** and lower backwards over the Change Centre.





# To raise Change Pad...



1a. Lift **Change Pad** up and pull into position.

2a. Engage front change pad press studs.



# **Bath Drainage...**



- 1a. Locate Bath drainage hole on underside of Bath.
- 1b. Connect Drain Hose to drainage hole.
